
Motion Detection - Technology that triggers recording or alerts only when movement is detected in the camera's field of view, saving storage space and highlighting significant events

PTZ Camera - Pan-Tilt-Zoom camera that can be remotely controlled to move horizontally (pan), vertically (tilt), and zoom in/out, providing comprehensive coverage from a single position

PDPA (Personal Data Protection Act) - Singapore legislation governing collection, use, disclosure, and protection of personal data including video surveillance footage

Remote Access - Ability to view live camera feeds and recorded footage from anywhere using internet-connected devices like smartphones, tablets, or computers
